Lord's Prayer

Mt 6:5-13

Lk 11:1-4 (short version)

Prayers/Commands/Declarations

Mt 8:3 ðI am willing; be cleansedö-Cleansing of leper.

Mt 8: 13 ðGo your way: and as you have believed, so let it be done to you.ö-Healing of centurion's servant.

Mt 8:32 ðGoö-Demons into swine.

Mt 9:2 ðSon, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you.ö-Paralytic.

Mt 9:6 ðArise, take up your bed and go to your house.ö-Paralytic.

Mt 9:22 ðBe of good cheer, daughter: your faith has made you wellö-Woman with an issue of blood. (cf. Mk 5:21-34)

Mt 9:29 ðAccording to your faith let it be done to you.ö-Blind men.

Mt 12:13 ðStretch out your hand.ö-Man with a withered hand.

Mt 15:28 ðO woman, great is your faith! Let it be done to you as you desire.ö-Woman who had faith for her demonized daughter.

Mt 17:18 And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour.-Epileptic boy.

Mk 1:25 ðBe quiet and come out of him!ö-Man with an unclean spirit.

Mk 1:42 And moved with compassion, He stretched out His hand, and touched him, and said to him, ðI am willing; be cleansed.ö-A leper.

Mk 2:5 ðMy son, your sins are forgiven.ö- Paralytic.

Mk 2:11 ðI say to you, rise, take up your pallet and go home.ö-Paralytic.

Mk 3:3 ðStretch out your handö-Man with a withered hand.

Mk 4:39 ðHush be stillö-Jesus rebuked the wind and sea.

Mk 5:8 ðCome out of the man, you unclean spirit!ö-The Gerasene demoniac.

Mk 5:41 And taking the child by the hand, He said to her, ðTalitha kum!ö which translated means, ðLittle girl, I say to you arise!ö).-The raising of a girl from the dead.

Mk. 9:25 ðYou deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and do not enter him again.ö-Epileptic boy.

Mk 10:52 And Jesus said to him, ðGo your way; your faith has made you well.ö

Lk 4:35 ðBe quiet and come out of him!ö-A demonized man in a synagogue.

Lk 4:39 And standing over her, He rebuked the fever, and it left her.-Peter's mother-in-law.

Lk 5:13 ðI am willing; be cleansed.ö-A man full of leprosy.

Lk 5:20 ðFriend, your sins are forgiven you.ö- A paralytic.

Lk 5:24 ðI say to you, rise, take up your stretcher and go home.ö-A paralytic.

Lk 6:10 ðStretch out your hand!ö And he did so; and his hand was restored.-A man with a withered right hand.

Lk 7:14 Young man, I say to you arise!ö And the dead man sat up, and began to speak. At a funeral procession outside of Nain.

Prayers of Jesus

Lk 7:48, 50 ðYour sins have been forgiven.ð ðYour faith has saved you: go in peace.ð-In response to the worship of a woman who was a sinner.

Lk 8:24 He rebuked the wind and the surging waves, and they stopped, and it became calm.

Lk 8:54 ðChild arise!ð-Dead daughter of a synagogue official.

Lk 13:12 ðWoman, you are freed from your sickness.ð- Woman who had a sickness for eighteen years that was caused by a spirit.

Lk 18:42 ðReceive your sight, your faith has made you well.ð-A blind man.

Jn 4:50 ðGo your way; your son livesð-Nobleman's son.

Jn 5:8 ðRise, take up your bed and walk!ð-Paralytic man at pool of Bethesda.

Jn 11:43 ðLazarus, come forth!ð-Raising of Lazarus who had been dead for four days.

Impartation of the Holy Spirit

Jn 20:21-23 So Jesus said to them again. Peace be with you! As the Father sent Me, I also send you.ð And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, ðReceive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.ð

Healing without prayer/No prayer recorded

Mt 20:34 ðSo Jesus had compassion and touched their eyes. And immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him.ð-Two blind men. (Absence of prayer noted) Mk 5:21-34-woman with an issue of blood (cf. Mt 9:20-22; Lk 8:40-46).

Mk 8:22-26-Blind man w/spit and laying on of hands.-progressive healing

Lk 14:4 And he took hold of him, and healed him, and sent him away.

Lk 17:14 ðGo, show yourselves to the priestsð And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed.-Ten lepers.

Lk 22:51 And He touched his ear and healed him. The man who's ear was cut off by Peter in Gethsemane.

Jn 9:6-7 Having said this, he spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes. "Go," he told him, "wash in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means Sent). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing. (NIV)-A man born blind.

Lk 10:21-22

For Children

Mt. 19:13-14 ðLittle children were brought to Him that He might put His hands on them and prayí and He laid His hands on them.

Mk 10:15 And He took them in His arms and began blessing them, laying His hands upon them.

Lk 18:15-17 Similar to Mt 19 and Mk 10, but Luke uses the word for babies or infants.
